

## 1. When do we sail?

The sailing season starts with the first ice, usually in the end of December. We recommend to plan your holiday in January and February, however March may also bring a good weather and sailing conditions.

Be aware that the weather may always change even from day to day and there are no 100% reliable forecasts.

Last seasons we advice to call us or visit our web site for up to date information about current weather and weather forecast. If your working time is flexible you can be almost sure to meet good sailing conditions.

## 2. Where do we sail?

We sail on the best ice. Our sailing area covers Sniardwy Lake and Mikolajskie Lake. We pick the best ice and set all equipment up.

## 3. Travel to Mikolajki

There are 3 ways to get to Mikolajki:

1. **By trane** – the end station is Olsztyn (about 100 km from Mikolajki) where we pick you up and transport back on the departure day. **The time table is available here.**
2. **By car** – due to bad road surface all over the country we have no advice which one to choose. When traveling from Berlin go via Poznan, Gniezno, Torun, Ostoleka, Olsztyn, Mragowo. To find Hotel Caligula see the **city plan.**
3. **By plane** – e-mail to discuss details.



## 4. Equipment

Our ice sailing price includes equipment. If you have your own ice boat bring it with you and sail with us. If you loved ice sailing we can built for you a special equipment or sale our second-hand. Currently for the 2002/2003 season we have 10 DNs (single person ice boats), 1 DX (double sitter) and The Caligula - new design for 6 persons with propelle.

## 5. Local weather information

From many different sources of information we recommend our **local weather report** updated at least twice a week, and the Internet weather forecast. The **local weather report** focuses on sailing conditions, ice thickness and our estimations on Sniardwy Lake - Polish biggest lake and our faithful sailing area, which is located in the specific micro climate thus making many forecasts inadequate. Please always verify sailing conditions on our site before making a decision.

## 7. Necessary to take with you...

To make travel comfortable we provide every participant with helmet. The rest of the winter clothes are up to you. Necessary are: warm shoes waterproof if possible - sometimes in plus temperatures water may appear on the ice, skiing overall, gloves, glasses, warm socks.
